



CPHS FRENCH IMMERSION COURSES

Carleton Place High School offers its students the opportunity to participate in the French Immersion program. In the French Immersion program, students accumulate 10 credits in French: four are French as a Second Language courses (FSL) and six are other subjects in which French is the language of instruction.

The following courses are available for students completing the French Immersion program.

- ***FIF1DF** (Gr. 9 French)
- ***FIF2DF** (Gr. 10 French)
- ***FIF3UF** (Gr. 11 French)
- ***FIF4UF** (Gr. 12 French)
- **CGC1DF** (Gr. 9 Canadian Geography)
- **PPL1OF/2OF** (Gr.9-10 co-ed Phys. Ed.)
- **PAF1OF/2OF** (Gr.9-10 co-ed CrossFit)
- **CHC2DF** (Gr. 10 Canadian History – alternating years)
- **CHV2OF & GLC2OF** (Gr. 10 Civics & Careers – alternating years)
- **HSP3UF** (Gr. 11 Intro to Psych/Soc/Anthro – alternating years)
- **Online CGF3MF** (Gr. 11 Physical Geography – usually available during the school year and in summer semester)
 - Other online options may be available (e.g. GLS1OF, HPC3OF, HFC3MF, HSB4UF) – varies year to year
- **CO-OP 32/34** (Gr. 11 or 12 Co-operative Education, 2 or 4 credit)
- **GPP3OF** (Gr. 11 or 12 Peer Tutoring – as available, and with teacher request)

*These four language courses must be included in the ten credits needed to complete the French Immersion certificate.
