

## **CPHS FRENCH IMMERSION COURSES**

Carleton Place High School offers its students the opportunity to participate in the French Immersion program. In the French Immersion program, students accumulate 10 credits in French: four are French as a Second Language courses (FSL) and six are other subjects in which French is the language of instruction.

The following courses are available for students completing the French Immersion program.

- PAF10F/20F (Gr.9-10 co-ed CrossFit)
- CHC2DF (Gr. 10 Canadian History alternating years)
- CHV2OF & GLC2OF (Gr. 10 Civics & Careers alternating years)
- **HSP3UF** (Gr. 11 Intro to Psych/Soc/Anthro alternating years)
- Online CGF3MF (Gr. 11 Physical Geography usually available during the school year and in summer semester)
  - Other online options may be available (e.g. GLS10F, HPC30F, HFC3MF, HSB4UF) –
    varies year to year
- CO-OP 32/34 (Gr. 11 or 12 Co-operative Education, 2 or 4 credit)
- GPP3OF (Gr. 11 or 12 Peer Tutoring as available, and with teacher request)
